

Kenya Education Network (KENET), is a not-for-profit organization licensed by Communications Authority of Kenya (CA) to serve education and research institutions. It provides affordable, cost-effective and low-congestion Internet bandwidth services to member institution campuses in Kenya. It has also setup a gateway to the advanced e-infrastructures for research that are available exclusively within the Research and Education Community anywhere in the world. In addition, KENET provides shared services such as; co-location of servers, dedicated Virtual servers for e-learning systems, video and web conferencing, and capacity building for technical staff.

On 20th September 2016, KENET organized a training workshop to sensitize the College of Health Sciences researchers on the resources available for their use in research and teaching. The workshop was geared towards highlighting the some of the capacities which are available although under-utilized by researchers such as:

1. Education services:
