The Partnership for Health Research Training in Kenya (P-HERT) program sponsored a course on Leadership and Management which was held from 11-15 March 2019 at the Paediatrics Training and Clinical Centre, College of Health Sciences, University of Nairobi. Leadership and Management course Training is a 30 hours course covering the following areas: introduction to leadership & management, introduction to MNCH policies, guidelines and indicators, social marketing and dissemination research, entrepreneurship in healthcare, human resource management, motivation and conflict management, introduction to health economics, effective communication, creating effective teams & time management, budgeting expenditure and accounting, financial records and statements for health, procurement & supplies management, project management, introduction to strategic planning and priority setting in health and monitoring and evaluation.

A total of 42 participants were trained. This included 8 P-HERT junior faculty fellows, 22 MMed Paediatrics and Child Health postgraduate finalists and 12 MMed Radiology postgraduate finalists.
